**DUE TO OVERWHELMING DEMAND!**  
**SECOND JIMMY BARNES CONCERT ANNOUNCED FOR MUDGEES**  
**SUNDAY OCTOBER 28 Noon - 6pm**

It's the news fans had been hoping for!

Promoters Roundhouse Entertainment today announced that due to phenomenal demand, a second Jimmy Barnes **'a day on the green'** concert at Craigmoor Winery (formerly Poet's Corner) is set for Sunday October 28.

This will be music to the ears of fans who missed out when the show on Saturday 27th smashed **'a day on the green'** records with 4500 tickets snapped up in eight days.

Since then fans have called and emailed Roundhouse and ticket agencies desperately trying to secure tickets. When it became obvious there was a massive demand, promoters began to look at the possibility of a second show.

Fortunately the stellar support cast of The Black Sorrows, Richard Clapton, Deborah Conway and Mahalia Barnes are all available for the Sunday event, making it the first time in **'a day on the green's'** Mudgee history that the concert will happen twice.

Please note as it is a Sunday, the event will run earlier than usual, with gates opening at 11.30am, music from 12.15pm and Jimmy Barnes on stage at 5pm. This will enable patrons to depart Mudgee by 7pm latest. Also it is worth noting that this is the Daylight Savings Weekend.

Tickets will be on sale on Friday (August 24) from ticketmaster.com. au & 136 100 and the Mudgee Bookcase on 6372 3127.

Promoter Michael Newton from Roundhouse Entertainment said: "They were so many disappointed people who missed out when the first show sold out so quickly that we were inundated with calls. It really was an incredible response and it made us start to think if it were even possible to do a second show on the Sunday.

"I'm really pleased we've been able to make it happen and give the opportunity for more people to see a performer who is not only an Australian rock icon, but also one of the best entertainers you'll ever see."
