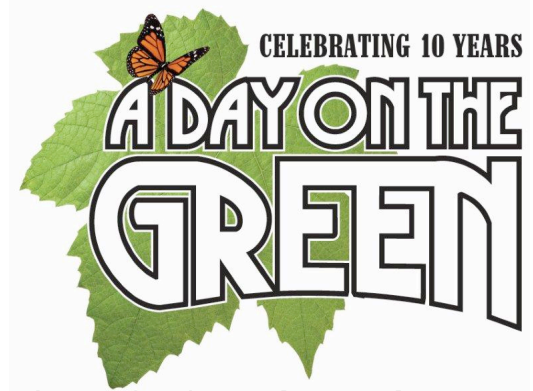

JIMMY BARNES HEADS 10 GREAT AUSSIE ARTISTS FOR 10th ANNIVERSARY CONCERTS!
